- Make sure to not put anything larger than a pea down your garbage disposal and avoid carrots, potato peels and eggshells, as they can cause clogs and damage your disposal.
- If you have pets, use a reflective tag with your updated information, so they're more visable at night and make sure to secure your pets during all the holiday activity.
