

SUMMER APARTMENT LIVING TIPS

- Close the blinds during the hottest part of the day: The more sunlight that comes into your home, the hotter it's going to get. You can decrease the heat in your apartment by keeping blinds closed or adding curtains/window coverings to the interior of your apartment. Tint, foil, and other foreign objects are not to be used in the windows as coverings. Once the sun goes down, you can open your blinds a little to allow some of the trapped heat to escape.
- . Optimize airflow: Even though you may not realize it, the air is moving and flowing through your apartment. When air conditioners or fans are running, the air is moving through every open room of your home. You can create a natural flow of the cooler air specifically to the rooms you're using by closing the doors to any rooms not in use. Keep doors open to places like your bedroom and bathroom. This ensures that the cool air flows to where you need it the most and will help ensure not to raise the humidity and helps prevent containing humid air within your apartment. Contact maintenance with any A/C concerns to ensure cool efficiency within your apartment.
- · Ceiling fan direction: If you have ceiling fans in your apartment, make sure they're rotating counterclockwise in the summer. This will push air downward, creating a wind chill effect.
- Run appliances in the evening: If your apartment has a dishwasher or washer/dryer, run them after the sun has set as temperatures increase during the day even without the added heat of appliances. Running them in the evening will keep your home cooler during the hours of the day when it's the warmest outside. Remember to run your dishwasher at lease once a month to prevent odors within its basin.

Balcony/Patio

- o Fire Regulations: No grills (charcoal or gas) are permitted to be used or stored on your patio no matter the size. The only exception would be an electric grill.
- Appearance: Rugs, towels, laundry, clothing, storage, appliances, trash, boxes, or other items not considered outdoor furniture, plants, etc. should not be stored on balconies/patios or draped/hung on railings or other portions of the balconies/patios.
- Patio Curtains/Privacy Screens: At no time are you allowed to use curtains, privacy screens or wire mesh on your patios unless you have written approval from the office.



Summer Drink - Cranberry Basil Spritzer

STEP 1

In a medium saucepan over medium-high heat, bring water and sugar to a boil. Stir to dissolve sugar. Add 1/2 cup basil leaves, remove pan from heat, and let steep for 20 minutes.

Strain syrup and let cool for at least 1 hour. In a large pitcher, combine syrup, unsweetened cranberry juice, and fresh lime juice.

Fill pitcher with chilled club soda, then add lime slices, fresh cranberries, and 1/2 cup basil leaves. To serve, pour spritzers over ice, top each with a splash more club soda, and garnish with basil.

INGREDIENTS
1 c. water
1 c. sugar
1/2 c. basil leaves
2 c. unsweetened cranberry juice
1/4 c. fresh lime juice
1 liter chilled club soda
4 slice lime
1 c. fresh cranberries
1/2 c. basil leaves
